
2050 Long-term climate strategy

- Published 28 November 2018
- Strategic long-term vision for a prosperous, modern, competitive and <u>climate-neutral</u> economy by 2050
- No new policies or revision or 2030 targets direction of travel for the long-term contribution to achieving Paris Climate Agreement
- Transport a key contributor <u>combination of approaches</u>
 - decarbonised, decentralised and digitalised power, modal shift, more efficient and sustainable batteries, highly efficient electric powertrains, connected, cooperative and automated driving -> 3016 Low Emission Mobility Strategy
- Key role for both light and heavy-duty transport sector
